- I am surprised to see Helen Hoyt Merrell's birthplace in June of 1860 as they were shown on the 1860 Census in LaFayette, but she was not yet born, only Harriet ae 2.⁵¹⁷⁷,

- In the January 17, 1888 issue of the Anthony Republican there is this note:

"In keeping with her well-known cordial hospitality, Mrs. E. G. Merrell entertained a party of friends at her residents last evening. Those attending speak in high terms of the social event."⁷¹⁶⁵

- Ed Merrell and family returned Saturday night from an all summer visit to their old home at Lafayette, N. Y.⁷⁷⁰¹
- "Carroll Hoyt of Anthony, Kansas and E. G. Merrell of the firm of E. G. Merrell furniture Company are in La Fayette."

- I've spent a little time looking through some of our materials:

In a book on Anthony history (1972), I found a list of Anthony residents as of 1885. In it is listed, "Merril, Ed; merchant." This is a different spelling, but I would speculate that the difference occurred in transcription from the original source. This would indicate that Mr. Merrell was here even earlier than you thought.

In the November 29, 1887 issue of the Anthony Republican, there is a box ad which reads:

"Blinds have been pulled down on prices of Curtains at Merrell & Darling's Furniture store, and are now being sold regardless of cost. Call early and get a bargain."

In the January 14, 1888, issue of the same newspaper is the following:

"A day or so ago, Mr. Wonner, of the Arcade Bakery, after procuring two hundred dollars of his son Charles, started for Wichita and having taken a drink from a bottle tendered him by a stranger, was drugged and robbed. When he came to his senses he was in a strange house in Wichita, his watch and every dollar was gone and he was penniless in the city. He ran across E.G. Merrell at the Occidental and told him the story, and that gentleman provided for his immediate wants and brought word home to his son Charles, who forwarded funds necessary for his father. The loss was a severe one."

In the process of looking for something else, I found this large ad in a December 31, 1897 newspaper:

E.G. Merrell & Co.

- Our old friend and former townsman, Edward G. Merrell, now living at Detroit, was married Tuesday, November 24, [1914] to Madeleine Ehle Day, of that city. The wedding took place at the residence of Rev. F. Dewey Ehle. After January 1 Mr. and Mrs. Merrill [sic] will be at home, 281 Lysander Pt. Mr. Merrill has very many friends at Anthony and in Harper county and all of them will wish him much joy and happiness.⁷⁸⁸⁵

- Miss Maud Merrell, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. E. G. Merrell, was quietly married on Thursday, to David Williams Mills, of Marysville. The ceremony was performed by Rev. William T. Jacquess, at the home of the bride's parents on Commonwealth avenue, only the immediate families being present. Mr. and Mrs. Mills have left for the south, where they will pass the remainder of the winter.³³⁷

- Mrs. David Mills Died Yesterday at Pasadena Home (Santa Cruz Sentinel, 29 Jan 1937)
News has been received from Pasadena announcing the death of Mrs. David W. Mills formerly of this city.
Death was caused by a heart attack and apparently Mrs. Mills had been in good health a few minutes before her passing.
Mr. and Mrs. Mills came to this city in 1925 and were prominent in the community life until 1929, Mr. Mills being connected as president with the Monterey Bay Redwood Company and was succeeded by J. A. Harris.

Mrs. Mills leaves to mourn her death her husband, son and daughter-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Nelson Mills and their small son.

Mrs. J. A. Harris and Mrs. Frank G. Wilson will leave early this morning for Pasadena to attend the funeral services which will be held at Forest Lawn Memorial Saturday at 2 p. m.⁷⁴⁹⁷

- MILLS – Mrs. Maud Mills, 692 South Grand Avenue, passed away Jan. 27, 1937. She was the beloved wife of David W. Mills, and mother of Nelson Mills. Funeral services will be held Saturday at 3:30 p. m. at the Wee Kirk o' the Heather, Glendale. Forest Lawn Memorial Park Association, Inc., in charge.¹⁰⁷³

- Harold remembers very well the funeral of Maud Mills at Forest Lawn in 1937. It was pouring rain. Her death had been sudden and unexpected. She was small of stature, was high strung, and smoked heavily.^{1160, p 2}

- My former next door neighbor used to speak of Maude Merrell as they were about the same age and were cousins through the Halls as Charles W. Hoyt's wives were daughters of Ezra Knapp and Mary Hall, the eldest child of General Isaac Hall.^{5177, p 1}

- Codicil [to Nelson Mills Will] appoints son David W. Mills as joint executor with Myron W. Mills.^{1133, p 6,1135, p 50, #172}

- SUIT INVOLVING OVER \$1,500,000

[excerpts] A suit was begun in the circuit court on Monday afternoon which involves real and personal property amounting to a million and a half dollars. Myron W. Mills and David Mills, executors of the estate of the late Nelson Mills are the complainants, and Mary M. Mills and Hannah E. Mills, administratrixes of the estate of the late Barney Mills, are the defendants. The suit is a friendly one, and is begun for the purpose of winding up the co-partnership of N. & B. Mills.

Judge Law ordered that Myron Mills and David Mills continue the business, sell the property, and close the estate as soon as possible.⁷⁰⁷⁰

- The marriage of Miss Maud Merrell, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. E. G. Merrell, to Mr. David Williams Mills, of Marysville, was quietly celebrated yesterday. The ceremony took place at the home of the bride's parents, Commonwealth Avenue, and Rev. William T. Jaquess officiated. Only the immediate families were present. After the ceremony Mr. and Mrs. Mills left for a trip south, where they will pass the remainder of the winter.³³⁸

- David W. is vice president of the Mills, Gray, Carleton Lumber Company, and makes his home in Cleveland. He was married in 1909 to Miss Maud Merrell, of Detroit, and they have one son, Nelson.^{50, p 684}

- The David W. Mills was a typical Great Lakes cargo vessel of the late 19th century. This wooden "steambarge" could carry over one million board feet of lumber. The vessel was originally named Sparta and was launched at Cleveland, Ohio on April 11, 1874. The vessel was renamed in 1910 after the manager of the Port Huron Navigation Company, the firm that owned the ship.

The Mills ran aground on Ford Shoals on August 11, 1919 in dense smog created by forest fires in Canada. Attempts to free the boat failed and it broke apart during a violent October storm.^{6413, p 2}

- Lived in Cleveland, Ohio, Santa Cruz, San Francisco, Los Angeles and Pasadena, Calif.¹

- Resided at 14186 Euclid Avenue, East Cleveland.³³⁶

- D. W. Mills, of Northern Ohio Lumber & Timber Co., Cleveland, Ohio, on his recent visit to California stated his company handled principally southern pine and Douglas fir, with small quantities of California sugar and white pine and red cedar siding.

Mr. Mills says the general feeling is towards a better business than last year.^{7526, p 2}

- It is a good question why David W. Mills picked up and moved to California? I don't know for sure, but I think I know some reasons why that might be the lumber business

was changing...lumber products were becoming more mechanically produced, and that likely meant it became even more of a commodity-priced product. (The high margin days...were likely behind him...in a significantly developed and mechanized market like Cleveland. Plus, going into the 1900s...steel was king.) But in California...it was still highly undeveloped. And the lure of going west where you can lead in an immature market likely had something to do with it as well. He probably had a good payday too...and like all business owners, perhaps seized upon "an exit strategy opportunity."⁷⁴⁹³

General: • The Wreck of the David W. Mills [excerpts]

The "David W. Mills" was a typical Great Lakes cargo vessel of the late 19th century. Measuring 202 feet by 34 feet by 13 feet, this wooden "steam barge" could carry over one million board feet of lumber. Built by Thomas Quayle and Sons Shipyard, the vessel was originally named "Sparta" and was launched at Cleveland, Ohio on April 11, 1874. The vessel was renamed in 1910 after the manager of the Port Huron Navigation Company, the firm that owned the ship. Captain Frank J. Peterson bought the "Mills" in 1919.

The "Mills" ran aground on Ford Shoals on August 11, 1919 in dense smog created by forest fires in Canada. Attempts to free the boat failed and it broke apart during a violent October storm.^{7064, p 2}

• I thought you might enjoy the knowledge that your family's history is still actively operating in Cleveland. That's just a great thing, I think. So I'm sending this note to share that.

NORTHERN OHIO [Lumber & Timber] is the oldest lumber company and sawmill in

the State of Ohio, founded in 1864, and has been operating for 156 continuous years in downtown Cleveland. The Company (around 12-15 employees) is a wholesale, commercial lumber and building materials supplier...for Professional Contractors, not a retail lumberyard with walk-in homeowner customers. We're still a sawmill...and cut custom heavy timber stock on a Mershon Timber Saw and an AM Timber Moulder-Planer, bought new at the time in Saginaw, Michigan — we assume by Nelson Mills — and installed here at NORTHERN OHIO in 1893. (Yes, they still operate on our Millhouse deck...we cut heavy timbers on them for other retail lumberyards and mostly commercial projects. I have attached some pictures of those machines. They were originally steam powered, but were converted to electric power in 1910.) We do other things now too...make heritage wood tabletops, doors, flooring, things like that. I joke that 156-year old companies have clearly learned to adapt. But that is totally accurate. ...with a lot of foresight and smarts, he [Nelson Mills] began assembling collaborative and timber supply partnerships (and shareholders in NORTHERN OHIO LUMBER in 1864 with Caleb Jewett and George Carleton) with multiple, local lumberyards and mills in what was then known in Cleveland as "The Lumber District," riverfront land on a bend in the Cuyahoga River just upstream from Lake Erie called Scranton Peninsula. NORTHERN OHIO strictly milled and supplied lumber for other Yards, not the public. That didn't stop him from also opening a local yard too though, N&B Mills. His son, David W. Mills (always signed his name DW Mills), was also a principal of NORTHERN OHIO up until the mid-1920's or 1930's when the company would eventually buy out all of the other Yards in the Lumber District.

- He was very prominent in town and a bio of him is found in the county history, Clayton's Onondaga in 1878.^{5177, p 2}
- [excerpts] Chas. W. Hoyt was born in the town of Pompey, Onondaga Co., N. Y. in 1804. His father came to this county in 1798. His father was a captain in the Revolutionary war, and drew a pension until his death. Chas. W. Hoyt, the subject of this sketch, was united in marriage, in 1824, to Miss Harriet Knapp, daughter of Ezra and Mary Knapp. Of this marriage were born three children. In 1842 he was married, the second time, to Miss Mary Knapp, sister to his first wife. Of this marriage was born three children.

Among the old men of this county, few, if any, can look back upon a life os so much hard labor as Chas. W. Hoyt, having cleared of the original forest, and caused to be cleared, many acres of land.

Like many other men who were, and are now, the bone and framework of this country, he now lives, in his seventy-fourth year, one of the few old living landmarks of our country's pioneers, surrounded by kind children to smooth his pathway as his time of release from earth draws near, having led a life of integrity and uprightness of character, honored by all who knew him, and at the writing of this brief sketch bids fair for more years of usefulness to his friends.⁷⁹⁹⁴

- VILLAGE OF LA FAYETTE.

This little hamlet lies about one mile west of the Syracuse, Binghamton and New York Railroad at Onativia, or LaFayette Station. It contains about twenty dwellings, a postoffice, a church, a hotel, three stores and two blacksmith shops.

Among the oldest settlers are C. W. Hoyt, Caleb B. Jackson, James Baker, Luther Baker and L. O. Hill.^{5180, p 5}

- Charles W. Hoyt was born in the town of Pompey on April 30th, 1804. He is the son of Ezekiel Hoyt, a Captain in the Revolutionary war. Captain Hoyt settled in Pompey in 1798 and was the father of eight children, of whom Charles was the youngest. Captain Hoyt owned about 400 acres on the State road, two miles east of Lafayette Square.

“Within my earliest recollections,” says Mr. Hoyt, “father had about twenty-five acres of clearing. Our house was a rude affair of logs, with but a single room below and a loft above for us children to sleep in.

The valleys on the east and west of this ridge - Sherman Hollow and Christian Hollow - extend the entire length of the town, and present an unusually rich and beautiful landscape when viewed from the summits.^{5180, p 1}

- General Isaac Hall, Wm. Alexander, Amos Palmetter, Jacob Johnson, Jacob Johnson, Jr., Obadiah Johnson, Elijah Hall, Peter Abbott, Rufus Kinney, Abner Kinney, Captain Joseph C. Howe and others, were among the pioneers in the south part of the town.^{5180, p 2}

- Previous to 1800, Gen. Isaac Hall came from Great Barrington, Mass., and settled one mile south of the village upon a soldier's claim. He purchased ten or twelve hundred acres of land, and was the wealthiest man in the town of Pompey, as it then was. It is said he brought into town with him half a bushel of silver dollars. He gave his attention to the raising of stock, it being his custom to let cows, sheep, colts, &c., to his neighbors and other citizens, to double. He died in 1830, worth about \$70,000.^{5180, p 3}

- Major Isaac Hall, who later rose to the rank of Brigadier-General of the Onondaga Brigade N.Y.S. Militia, was probably the most prominent and certainly the wealthiest of the early settlers. When the Halls arrived here in the winter of 1797 they cleared a pathway into their property and built a log cabin. This was ever afterward the driveway of the farm and is now Sturgeon Drive. Four years later they built a frame house which was the second such structure in the whole of the present town. This was replaced in 1817 by the commodious dwelling which stood on the site for 155 years. At his death, September 22, 1830 aged 66, Isaac Hall owned 1,442 acres and left an estate valued at \$70,000.^{5179, p 6}

- The History books tell us that he brought with him from Massachusetts when he came here in February of 1797 a half bushel of silver dollars. A Syracuse University professor has computed this to be 1,365 silver dollars. When he died he owned over 1400 acres and was one of the wealthiest men in Central New York. I have photographs of his house, now gone, owned by Charles W. Hoyt from abt 1846 to 1867.⁵²³⁸

- Isaac Hall enlisted in 1780 and served as a private in a Massachusetts regiment until 1782. He later rose to the rank of Brigadier General in the New York State Militia.^{5239, p 1}

- General Isaac Hall settled in New Marlboro Mass. and married Vashti Johnson of that place; they moved to Pompey, Onondaga Co. N.Y. in 1797. In 1817 he built on his land the house that is still standing. This land was kept in the Hall family until within a few years when it was sold to its present owner Mr. L.R. Gaylord. The descendants of Isaac Hall are still living in Onondaga Co. most of them in Syracuse, N.Y. These are the facts.⁵²⁴⁸

We are told that Isaac Hall was a saddler. A hammer which he used at his trade is now in the possession of Clifford J. Clark who resides at LaFayette. He must have turned from his trade as it was said that he was the richest man in Onondaga County when he moved to LaFayette. He bought a farm about a mile south of LaFayette Square. He built a log house on what is known as the "Dug Road." Subsequently he built a fine large house a number of rods north of the log house. After the death of Isaac Hall his home was owned by Charles Hoyt and was much later owned by Frank Cummings who were descendants of I. Hall.

Isaac Hall was a large man, dark hair and eyes. He always wore blue broadcloth

clothes, sometimes a mulberry color, with brass buttons on the coat and a white ruffled shirt. He was a distinguished looking figure when he walked into the LaFayette Church. He always carried his whip into church fearing boys might tamper with it if left in the wagon in the shed. Great Grandfather Isaac Hall was very fond of dress. The travelling tailor would come along and stop at his house several weeks and make up a number of suits for him from broadcloth and buttons which he had provided for himself. I suppose he sent to New York for the broadcloth and it was undoubtedly weeks before he received it. The travelling cobbler would also come along and remain at the house some time making shoes for the entire family. The boys' clothes were made the mothers out of "homespun" and the cast off clothes of the fathers.^{5249, p 273}
