• In the assault by the French and Indians 29 Feb. 1704, he, with his wife and the children, Jonathan, Sarah, Ebenezer, and Abigail were made prisoners and carried away for Canada, but the youngest was killed on the road, and the deacon perished of hunger near the lower Cohos; the widow and two elder children came back, while Ebenezer remained in that country.⁹, pp 480-1

• The other [son], David, is better known in history. He was born in 1651, and removed to Hadley, Mass., before 1679, and to Deerfield as early as 1682, where he was deacon and lieutenant. He was three times married, and had eight children. When the Indians attacked Deerfield, in 1704, his eldest son was killed in the "meadow fight," and himself, his wife, and four children were carried away captive. The youngest, a child three or four years old, was killed by the Indians on the road. The deacon himself, then fifty-three years of age, died of starvation near the "Lower Cohos." One son, Ebenezer, remained among the Indians but the widow, one son, and a daughter, returned from captivity.¹, p 251

• We have spoken of David Hoyt, who suffered death by starvation among the Indians, while two of his family were slain by them, and others endured for years the horrors of Indian captivity in Canada, one of whom never returned, and may possibly have left descendants among the red-skins of the forest.¹, p 254

• Died of starvation in British prison.

• He was about 11 years old when Deerfield was attacked. Tradition says that, hearing the screams in the nights, his fright led him to jump from a window and hide in a corn-bin, where he lay till morning. Then, finding all gone but the slain, he wished he had been taken with the others. Some accounts say that he removed with his mother, after her return, to Wallingford, Ct. Others state that he went to Norwalk, Ct., and remained there for some time with his father's relatives. Perhaps he may have been at both places. Afterwards, he with 20 or 30 others commenced a settlement at Ridgefield, 12 miles south of Norwalk, where he afterwards resided.^{1, p 329}

Among the old men of this county, few, if any, can look back upon a life os so much hard labor as Chas. W. Hoyt, having cleared of the original forest, and caused to be cleared, many acres of land.

Like many other men who were, and are now, the bone and framework of this country, he now lives, in his seventy-fourth year, one of the few old living landmarks of our country's pioneers, surrounded by kind children to smooth his pathway as his time of release from earth draws near, having led a life of integrity and uprightness of character, honored by all who knew him, and at the writing of this brief sketch bids fair for more years of usefulness to his friends.²⁷

- VILLAGE OF LA FAYETTE.

This little hamlet lies about one mile west of the Syracuse, Binghamton and New York Railroad at Onativia, or LaFayette Station. It contains about twenty dwellings, a postoffice, a church, a hotel, three stores and two blacksmith shops.

Among the oldest settlers are C. W. Hoyt, Caleb B. Jackson, James Baker, Luther Baker and L. O. Hill.^{18, p 5}

- Charles W. Hoyt was born in the town of Pompey on April 30th, 1804. He is the son of Ezekiel Hoyt, a Captain in the Revolutionary war. Captain Hoyt settled in Pompey in 1798 and was the father of eight children, of whom Charles was the youngest. Captain Hoyt owned about 400 acres on the State road, two miles east of Lafayette Square.

"Within my earliest recollections," says Mr. Hoyt, "father had about twenty-five acres of clearing. Our house was a rude affair of logs, with but a single room below and a loft above for us children to sleep in.

The surface of the town is hilly and broken, the high ridge between Butternut and Onondaga Creeks, the two principal streams, having steep declivities and rising from three to six hundred feet in altitude. The valleys on the east and west of this ridge - Sherman Hollow and Christian Hollow - extend the entire length of the town, and present an unusually rich and beautiful landscape when viewed from the summits.^{18, p 1}

- Mrs. Edward G. Merrell, wife of a Detroit business man, visiting her daughter, Mrs. Mills, Forest Hill-rd, East Cleveland, wife of D. W. Mills, treasurer of the Mills-Carleton Co., lumber dealers, died from apoplexy last night while out to mail a letter.

- I've spent a little time looking through some of our materials:

In a book on Anthony history (1972), I found a list of Anthony residents as of 1885. In it is listed, "Merril, Ed; merchant." This is a different spelling, but I would speculate that the difference occurred in transcription from the original source. This would indicate that Mr. Merrell was here even earlier than you thought.

In the November 29, 1887 issue of the Anthony Republican, there is a box ad which reads:

"Blinds have been pulled down on prices of Curtains at Merrell & Darling's Furniture store, and are now being sold regardless of cost. Call early and get a bargain."

In the January 14, 1888, issue of the same newspaper is the following:

"A day or so ago, Mr. Wonner, of the Arcade Bakery, after procuring two hundred dollars of his son Charles, started for Wichita and having taken a drink from a bottle tendered him by a stranger, was drugged and robbed. When he came to his senses he was in a strange house in Wichita, his watch and every dollar was gone and he was penniless in the city. He ran across E.G. Merrell at the Occidental and told him the story, and that gentleman provided for his immediate wants and brought word home to his son Charles, who forwarded funds necessary for his father. The loss was a severe one."

In the process of looking for something else, I found this large ad in a December 31, 1897 newspaper:
