

• Son of Robert William and Isabella (Kewley) McMorran.<sup>29, p 886</sup>

• Little is to be said of Mr. McMorran's honorable career, which is now in its zenith. He has enjoyed, is enjoying and will continue to enjoy the confidence and respect of the people of his city. The citizens of Port Huron have repeatedly shown their appreciation of his untiring industry and sterling integrity, and there is every reason to feel that there will be no departure from the confidence they have always shown. His executive ability is of a high order. Both in his official and in his private life, Mr. McMorran deserves and has the highest esteem of his fellow men.<sup>29, p 887</sup>

• The Mills Transportation Company was formed February 4, 1878, with a capital stock of \$250,000, divided into 10,000 shares of \$25 each. Nelson Mills, of Marysville, held 2,812; Barney Mills, 938; August C. Gray, 1,250; Henry McMorran, Port Huron, 2,500; and Charles Neal, Bay City, 2,500 shares.<sup>29, p 547</sup>

• He was elected as a Republican to the fifty-eighth Congress. He was reelected and served five consecutive terms from March 4, 1903 to March 3, 1913. He was not a candidate in 1912.

Speaker of the House Joseph G. Cannon publicly commended Mr. McMorran for his service to the nation. He credited the Port Huron industrialist with saving the country large sums of money by closely watching government expenditures.<sup>1057</sup>

• McMorran, Henry Gordon, a Representative from Michigan; born in Port Huron, Mich., June 11, 1844; attended the Crawford Private School; engaged in the wholesale grocery business in 1865 and also in the milling, grain, and elevator business; member of the board of aldermen in 1867; city manager of Port Huron in 1875; general manager of the Port Huron & Northwestern Railway 1878-1889; member of the State canal commission; elected as a Republican to the Fifty-eighth and to the four succeeding Congresses (March 4, 1903-March 3, 1913); chairman, Committee on Manufactures (Sixtieth and Sixty-first Congresses); was not a candidate for renomination in 1912; engaged in numerous business enterprises at Port Huron, Mich.; organized the Great Lakes Foundry Co., serving as its president; died in Port Huron, Mich., July 19, 1929; interment in Lakeside Cemetery.<sup>2353</sup>

• Much of the information that we have was given to us by Todd's Aunt Charlotte (Chotty) McMorran -- who died on 2 June 1991. She had done much work back in the 50's as her aunt and father from the 90's through the 30's. Virtually nothing that she gave us is documented, which necessitated doing a lot of it over again. Chotty was a wonderfully bright and intelligent woman, but was a hypochondriac who became a virtual recluse. We had not seen her for about 10 years. We excited her too much and she always suffered a decline after our visits. So she simply put a stop to them. She left the contents of her house to Todd. There is much to be sifted through and we only had a limited amount of time to assess what was there. Much of it is in storage in Port Huron until we can make arrangements to bring it to Meadville. From our cursory look through family papers, the most valuable material seems to be the hundreds of photographs we discovered. As one might expect, many, many are unidentified. There are a few 'Mills' photos that are identified (most had to be left in Port Huron).<sup>1394, p 1</sup>

• Are Thomas McMorran and Robert McMorran brothers? My guess is if they are brothers, they are half-brothers and here is why.<sup>7455</sup>

• He emigrated to America when 21 years of age, and settled in Port Huron, Mich.<sup>1059, p 2</sup>

• Robert William MacMorran: b. Dec 25, 1816 d. 1855. After his return to Scotland he ran away back to America but being under age his family brought him back to Edinburgh. However, as soon as he was of age he again sailed for America and lived for a time in New York, then came to Port Huron, Mich., where he imported fine woolens for the tailors from England and Scotland. He had a sun stroke a year before his death and in his delirium destroyed all family records."<sup>7455</sup>

• According to their marriage certificate, Robert and Isabella McMorran were married in Port Huron, Michigan on the 25th of December 1842 (Exhibit E(4)). At the time of his marriage Robert was 23 and Isabella was 18. This recorded document provides proof Robert was most likely born in 1819 and not 1816. If Robert had been born in 1816, he would have been 26 on his wedding day, not 23.<sup>7455, p 6</sup>

• Hugh MacMorran: An owner of woolen mills in Lanark. Came to Charleston, S.C. where he died of yellow fever in 1821. His widow, Jean Gordon MacMorran returning to Edinburgh, Scotland (where she remarried) taking with her her son Robert William MacMorran.<sup>7455</sup>

• Hugh MacMorran married a Jane Finlay. This could be Jean or Jane. Her maiden name was Gordon. I found a marriage certificate for a Jean Gordon and Andrew Finlay on Ancestry who were married on Nov. 13, 1793, in Midlothian, Edinburgh (Exhibit E(1). I found a Birth Certificate for a John Finlay born to Andrew Finlay and Jean Gordon with a birthdate of March 6, 1801 in Edinburgh (Exhibit E (2)). I believe John Finlay was Jean/Jane McMorran's son from her marriage to Andrew Findlay. His date of birth and his age on the ship manifest to South Carolina is about right.<sup>7455, p 6</sup>
